AAR SUPPLY CHAIN, INC. (“AAR” or “we”) takes your concerns about privacy seriously. This Privacy Policy (“**Privacy Policy**”) explains how we collect, use, and protect your information on or through this website, including mobile site, blog, app, email, social media, feature, software, product, service, information, or content made available, displayed, or offered by or through AAR (collectively, this “**Software**”). By using this Software, you consent to AAR’s Privacy Policy. If you have any question about this Privacy Policy, please contact us at airvolutionsupport@aarcorp.com.

I. Data Collection

We may collect your personal data or personally identifiable information (“**PII**”). For example, you may be asked to enter your email address or other details when you take certain actions on or through our Software, such as providing feedback, or otherwise entering information on our Software.

Where possible, our server automatically recognizes and collects certain information regarding visitors to the Software, including by way of example, IP address, browser type, and other information regarding the system and connection of each visitor or user. It is essentially “traffic data,” which is helpful to us for improving our services. For example, it enables us to diagnose problems with our server and identify which areas of the Software are most heavily used. Such traffic data collection does not follow a user’s activities on any other sites in any way. Sometimes, we utilize the services of a third party to help us understand this information better.

II. Sensitive Information

AAR does not knowingly solicit or collect, and you should not provide, any information regarding your medical or health condition, race or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or other sensitive information.

III. Cookies

As with many websites, AAR may use the standard “cookies” feature of major web browsers to enhance your user experience. Cookies are small files that a website or a service provider stores on your computer that contain certain information about the user. We may also use third party services to track this information on our behalf.

You may set your web browser to disable cookies or to warn you every time a cookie is sent. See your browser’s Help menu for these instructions. We do not plant or track cookies or use advertising when a Do Not Track (DNT) browser mechanism is in place, and we do not allow third party behavioral tracking. Please note that disabling cookies may diminish your experience on the Software and some features that make your user experience more efficient may not work as intended. Please refer to your browser or email software instructions or help screen to learn more about these functions.

IV. Use of Data

We use the PII you submit to personalize your user experience and to allow us to deliver the type of content, service, or product offering in which you are most interested. We may also use your PII to compile usage statistics and other data regarding the use of AAR’s services and/or products.

We may employ other companies and individuals to perform such functions on our behalf. They have access to PII needed to perform their functions but may not use it for any other purpose.

We rely on our legitimate interests when using your PII for these purposes. We may also use your PII: (i) when it is necessary to perform a contract we have with you (e.g., our Terms and Conditions of Use or other agreements); (ii) when it is required by law; and/or (iii) when we have your consent.

V. Third Party Disclosure

AAR does not sell, rent, trade, or otherwise transfer your name, email address, or any other PII to third parties, outside of the following limited circumstances. We may disclose PII to third parties: (a) if we have your consent; (b) if a service provided on our site requires interaction with a third party, or is provided by a third party, such as an application service provider; (c) with our advisors, for example, to enforce or apply our Terms and Conditions of Use, Privacy Policy, or other agreement; (d) to comply with the law, such as when AAR, its owners, partners, sponsors, investors, or affiliates are served with legal process; or (e) to protect and defend the rights, property, or safety of AAR, our users, or others, including exchanging information with other companies and organizations for fraud protection. AAR has not sold your PII to third parties in the twelve (12) months prior to the date of this Privacy Policy, and AAR is not selling your PII to any third parties for their own direct marketing purposes. In the event of a disclosure required by law, we will use reasonable efforts to provide notice of this disclosure (which may be no notice) to all affected users, to the extent reasonably possible under the circumstances.

Note that whenever you voluntarily make your PII available online for viewing by third parties, such as on blogs, message boards, listings, or chat areas, the information you share also can be seen, collected, and used by third parties. We cannot be responsible for any unauthorized third party use of such information that you voluntarily share.

VI. International Transfers

Given that we are an international business, our use of your PII necessarily involves the transmission of data on an international basis. If you are located in the European Union, the UK, or elsewhere outside of the United States, please be aware that information we collect may be transferred to and processed in the United States. Where such transfers take place, and where required by law, we utilize valid cross-border data transfer mechanisms (such as the standard contractual clauses).

VII. Your Rights

Depending on where you are located, you may be entitled to certain rights relating to your PII. For example, you may be able to:

- Request certain information regarding our disclosure of your PII to third parties for their own direct marketing purposes.
- Request to know: (i) the specific pieces of PII we have collected about you; (ii) the categories of PII we have collected about you; (iii) the categories of sources from which we collected your PII; (iv) our business purpose for collecting your PII; and (v) the categories of third parties with whom we shared your PII.
- Request to delete the PII we have collected about you or object to our further use of such PII. We may deny your request under certain circumstances, such as if we need to comply with a legal obligation.
- Request to correct the PII we have collected about you, if you believe that the PII we have collected about you is inaccurate or incomplete.
- Request that we limit the use of your PII, in certain circumstances.
- Request that we transfer PII you have provided to us to a third party, in certain circumstances.

- Withdraw your consent, where we rely on your consent to use your PII.
- Complain to a data protection authority about our use of your PII.

IX. No Spam

We will take the necessary steps to ensure that we are compliant with the CAN-SPAM Act of 2003. The CAN-SPAM Act is a law that sets the rules for commercial emails and messages.

Accordingly, we agree to: (a) not use false, misleading, or deceptive header information or subject lines; (b) identify the message as an advertisement, where applicable; (c) include the physical address of our business; (d) honor opt-out/unsubscribe requests promptly; (e) allow users to unsubscribe by using the link at the bottom of each email; and (f) monitor third party email marketing service for compliance, if one is used.

X. Data Storage and Security

Your personal information is stored through a data management system. Your information can be accessed only by those who help manage that information and are required to keep the information confidential. We only keep your PII for as long as is needed to fulfill the purposes identified in this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise required or permitted by law.

AAR will use at least industry standard measures on the Software to protect the loss, misuse, and alteration of the information under our control. While there is no such thing as "perfect security" on the Internet, AAR will take reasonable steps to provide for the safety of your personal information. For example, our policy is that only those individuals who need your PII to perform a specific job are granted access to that PII. Likewise, all employees and contractors are kept up-to-date on our security and privacy practices.

XI. No Guarantee

YOU SHOULD NOT PROVIDE AAR WITH ANY PII (OR SUBMIT OR POST ANY PII TO THE SITE OR IN RESPONSE TO ANY EMAIL OR OTHER COMMUNICATION) UNLESS YOU WOULD LIKE THAT INFORMATION TO BE USED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS POLICY.

XII. Assignment

In the event of an assignment, sale, joint venture, or other transfer of some or all of our assets, you agree we can assign, sell, license, or transfer any information that you have provided to us. Please note, however, that any purchasing party is prohibited from using the PII submitted to us under this Privacy Policy in a manner that is materially inconsistent with this Privacy Policy without your prior consent.

XIII. Notification of Changes

We will notify users of any changes to this Privacy Policy. Notification will either be made by way of an e-mail or by posting of the changes on the Software. Changes to this Policy will be effective 30 days following notice. Your continued use of the Software after any change has become effective will constitute your acceptance of that change.

Unless we seek and receive consent from a user, we will use information we collect from users in accordance with the version of the Privacy Policy effective when the information was last collected.
